NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Sonoma County Fire District (“District”) intends to conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, October 20, 2020, at 5:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, to consider a resolution concerning the approval of the District’s Fire Impact Fee Nexus Study and approval of new fire impact fees charged on new development pursuant to California Government Code Section 66000 et al.

The Public Hearing will be held pursuant to Executive Order N-29-20 issued by California Governor Gavin Newsom on March 17, 2020. The District Board of Directors will attend the meeting via teleconference. For those seeking to attend and comment at the meeting, the teleconference link will be made available at least 72 hours before the hearing on the District’s website and included in the posted Board agenda.

The Fire Impact Fee Nexus Study for the proposed fire impact fees will be available for public review on September 21, 2020. Members of the public are invited to provide comment at the public hearing, or, in writing, which is received on or before October 15, 2020. Any person challenging in court the decision made at the conclusion of the public hearing may be limited to raising only those issues raised at such hearing or in correspondence delivered to the District prior to the close of such hearing.
